Effective the 2016-17 Academic Year the Doctoral Registration system was revised as follows:

1. The separate annual tracks for Scholastic and Advanced Residence were eliminated. Students are now tracked by their successive years since initial enrollment in a Doctoral Program.
2. All enrolled doctoral students are full-time. The half-time registration status was eliminated.
3. For students initially enrolling in a Doctoral Program in the 2016-17 Academic Year, they are required to graduate by the end of the ninth year.  
Students who initially enrolled in a Doctoral Program prior to the 2016-17 Academic Year are required to graduate by the end of the twelfth year (or tenth year for Social Service Administration).
