Doctoral LOA = Ph.D. students on leave from their programs per residence system policies.

Doctoral Leave-of-Absence Quarter 1 (A) = Ph.D. students on the first quarter of a leave of less than six months, able to defer loan repayments.

Doctoral Leave-of-Absence Quarter 2 (A) = Ph.D. students on the second quarter of a leave of less than six months, able to defer loan repayments.

Doctoral Leave-of-Absence Qtrs 1 & 2 (W) = Ph.D. students in the first two quarters of a leave of more than six months, unable to defer loan repayments.

Doctoral Leave-of-Absence 3rd and Subsequent Quarters = Ph.D. students in the 3rd or subsequent quarter of a leave, unable to defer loan repayments.

Doctoral Registration not Required = Ph.D. students using this quarter as the one quarter per academic year of non-enrollment as allowed by residence system policies.
